# Safe Schools During the Pandemic

Since the COVID-19 breakout in March 2020, most of our NTT schools have adjusted to small home group schooling where teachers pay scheduled monitoring visits started effectively in April 2020.

During this period, Local Dept. of Education of West Manggarai, Southwest Sumba & Kupang sent out disinfectant team to sanitize school buildings covering both interior and exterior facilities.

Areas with lower to none COVID cases are allowing their schools to switch operation from home learning to school learning with more rigid implementation of pandemic protocols such as distanced seating, keeping mask on, 20-sec hand washing rule & shorter class periods as well as school administrative hours.

**These regulations and adjustments resulted in lower school attendance, postponed trainings, slower construction and delayed inaugurations in 2020.**
